



RURAL TOURISM JUJUY - THE COMMUNITIES ARE WAITING FOR YOU - SELF DRIVE

Cities of the circuit: JUJUY -PURMAMARCA-TILCARA-HUMAHUACA-OCUMAZO-POZO COLORADO

Number of days: 8 DAYS / 7 NIGHTS

Activities: CULTURE – TRADITION- NATURE

If we speak of community tourism, we are referring to local and rural enterprises developed by indigenous peoples and local Creole communities that engage in tourism activity.

DAY 01: JUJUY

Arrival at Jujuy airport. **Pick up of vehicle category to be selected.**

Suggested visit: Tour around the city of Jujuy.

City in the northwest of Argentina, capital of the province of Jujuy. Popularly known as "Tacita de Plata", it is located in a fertile valley, at the confluence of the Grande and Xibi Xibi rivers, surrounded by colourful mountains that are usually covered with snow in winter.

Overnight at selected hotel.

DAY 02: JUJUY - PURMAMARCA –TILCARA – HUMAHUACA - OCUMAZO

Breakfast at the hotel.

SUGGESTED ITINERARY TO VISIT RURAL TOURISM COMMUNITIES IN JUJUY

Departure to Purmamarca, famous town where you can see the seven colours hill, visiting the archaeological site Pucara de Tilcara, old fortress built by the natives of the ravine and the town of Humahuaca.

Your tour can continue along the routes that take you to Ocumazo, a site where community tourism families are located. Small community located 18 km from Humahuaca in the Valle Escondido. Its inhabitants practice small-scale agriculture, growing their own Andean products such as corn, a variety of Andean potatoes, ollucos and beans. They are especially dedicated to the conservation of Andean seeds.

Overnight in a family home of community tourism.

DAY 3 – OCUMAZO COMMUNITY

Breakfast

This day can be dedicated to living with the host family, walking around the village or participating in cooking workshops, cheese making and rural activities.

DAY 4: OCUMAZO / HORNOCAL / OCUMAZO

Breakfast

One of the hidden treasures of the region is the Serranías del Hornocal, a landscape of stunning colours and great natural beauty.

To reach the top of Santa Ana hill, from where you get the best view of the Hornocal, you must climb up to 3900 metres where the viewpoint is located.

Overnight in a family home of community tourism.

DAY 5: OCUMAZO COMMUNITY / PURMAMARCA

Breakfast

The suggested itinerary continues with the return to Purmamarca, to enjoy a full day and the next day continue to Salinas Grandes, to visit and live with a family in the region.

Overnight at selected hotel.

DAY 6: PURMAMARCA / SALINAS GRANDES / POZO COLORADO

Breakfast at the hotel

Departure to Salinas Grandes, via Cuesta de Lipán with destination Pozo Colorado to make a caravan with llamas (It is recommended to travel this route when the sun has risen and the fog has lifted).

Pozo Colorado is a beautiful spot with a small hamlet. It is located on the eastern edge of the Salinas Grandes. It is an aboriginal community that is especially dedicated to the productive activity of salt extraction and livestock, specifically to the breeding of llamas. The community is working to recover its cultural heritage: spinning and weaving llama wool; carving stone slabs; salt stone crafts.

Overnight in a family home of community tourism.

DAY 7: POZO COLORADO / PURMAMARCA / JUJUY OR SALTA

Breakfast

Return to Jujuy or Salta.

Overnight at selected hotel.



DAY 8: JUJUY OR SALTA

Breakfast at the hotel

Departure to the airport. Drop off vehicle rental.
