

TERMAS DE RÍO HONDO

Located in the Province of Santiago del Estero, it is the main thermal centre of the country, since it is located over fourteen mesothermal water layers. These waters are qualified as alkaline, bicarbonated, chlorosulphate and ferruginous, containing small amounts of iron, sodium, phosphorus and iodine. The city was founded in 1954 and has restaurants, a casino, a handicraft fair, the Güemes Park, the Nuestra Señora del Perpetuo Socorro Church, the Costanera, the Autodromo and the La Olla Municipal Spa. Near the city, on the Dulce River, you can visit the Frontal Dam, where you can practice nautical sports and where the traditional Food Fair takes place.

City Tour with Frontal Dam and Lake - Half Day.


The city's waterfront stretches for 7 kilometres. The first sector runs from the Access Bridge to the dam, along the banks of the Dulce River. This waterfront has four service nodes, two of them with beautiful coffee shops. All along its route, the palm trees give a paradisiacal



touch to the place. It is ideal for walks, cycling, and bird and flora watching. The second sector extends from the racetrack to the airport, bordering the immense lake of Termas de Río Hondo.

The Río Hondo dam is located on the border between the provinces of Tucumán and Santiago del Estero. It is a large-scale work for flood attenuation, irrigation and drinking water supply, hydroelectricity generation, tourism and fish farming development. The lake of this large reservoir is almost equally divided between the two provinces. Sports such as jet skiing, water skiing, rowing and fishing are practised here, and a variety of national and international competitions are held every year. The warm lake has a great wealth of fish (dorados, bogas, catfish, tarariras, shads, pejerreyes) and a good beach on the left bank and ideal places for camping.

Visita Autódromo Internacional con museo – Medio día.

The modern Automobile Museum is located in the grounds of the Las Termas de Río Hondo Race Track. It exhibits an important sample of collection vehicles, some of which are from the Fangio, La Plata and Arturo Scalise museums, and it treasures the largest amount of



antique motorbikes. This museum is a fundamental attraction for the visitors and neighbours of Termas de Río Hondo, being part of the infrastructure of services of the thermal city. The permanent exhibition of the Automobile Museum of Termas de Río Hondo is presented as a tour that takes visitors on a journey through outstanding moments of motor racing and motorcycling in Argentina and the world. This circuit is organised in six spaces that include cars and motorbikes that have been the protagonists of unforgettable pages in the great history of motor sports: Turismo Carretera, Sport Histórico, Espacio Fangio, Industria Nacional and Formula 1.

Visit Tafí del Valle - Full day.

Although Tafí has grown a lot in the last few years and has become the destination par excellence for Argentineans and foreigners 365 days a year, it still holds within its hills the mystery of its aboriginal culture.



Tafí del Valle radiates a tradition of handicrafts that leaves its mark all over the valley. Tourists will find local craftsmen's workshops offering their products made of wool, leather, stone, ceramics, etc.
